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**Written Summary**

Henry Long built this house. Subsequent owners include Oren Long and Marvin Barr. Part of this house was moved up to its current location from its original site near the creek (Gwynne Taylor).

This two-story side-gable-roofed log house has a shed-roofed front porch supported by square posts on very short brick piers, six-over-six sash windows, a replacement front door, asphalt shingle siding with an ashlar pattern, exposed rafter ends, a metal roof, a brick end chimney with a corbelled stack, an enclosed porch on the main block's rear (south) elevation, and a gabled one-story rear wing with an enclosed porch on its east elevation. This property was for sale in 2006 (HF).
