**Written Summary**

No historic house at this location; overgrown lot (HF).

Reuben Holder built this house in the late nineteenth century. Subsequent owners include Martha Wilson, the Wolff family, Ed Pfaff, B. B. Griffin, Gaither Beroth, Dave Hill, and George Myers, who owned the property in 1979 (Sadie Wilson, 1979; GT).

This one-story, side-gable-roofed, asbestos-sided dwelling had four-over-four sash windows, sidelights flanking the front door, brick end chimneys with stepped shoulders, and a gabled rear wing. A smokehouse stood behind the house (GT; HF).
