Pfafftown Christian Church owns this cemetery. The earliest (mid- to late-nineteenth-century) section is in the northeast corner. Modest marble and granite markers for families including the Transous, Pfaffs, and Wilsons are situated along a paved road that winds through cemetery and past the centrally-located frame gazebo (HF).
