Written Summary

Wade H. Yarborough owned Vienna Lumber Company, sold insurance, and served on the Bethania and Pleasant Ridge School Committees. His wife, Annette Flynt, was a teacher (Gwynne Taylor).

This aluminum-sided I-house has a wraparound porch that has been enclosed at the north end, a double-leaf front door, two brick interior chimneys, a metal roof, and a rear shed addition. Four-over-four, four-over-one, and replacement one-over-one sash windows illuminate the interior. A small gable surmounts the front porch entrance and the bungalow porch posts have been replaced with turned posts since 1979. The one-story gabled rear ell has a brick interior chimney and an engaged screened porch on its south elevation (HF).
