Written Summary

John Schultz built this house. Subsequent owners included Susannah Schultz Blakeley, Will Roberts (who made the Victorian-era changes), and Winfree Hines. An enclosed corner stair originally led from the west room to the second story (Gwynne Taylor).

This two-story, side-gable-roofed, aluminum-sided log house has a late-nineteenth-century front door and hip-roofed front porch supported by bracketed turned posts spanned by a wood railing, six-over-six sash windows, a brick end chimney with a stepped base and shoulders on the west elevation, a one-story rear shed addition, a one-story rear gabled ell with an enclosed porch on its west elevation, and a new corrugated metal roof (HF).
