**Written Summary**

Frederick Leonard Ziglar built a one-story house (now the rear ell) at this location in 1894 and added an I-house on the front in 1904. D. W. Ziglar, who inherited the property, was the owner in 1979. The house is insulated with brick nogging (Gwynne Taylor).

This vinyl-sided I-house has a projecting two-story pedimented bay at the façade's center, a wraparound porch supported by bracketed turned posts, original two-over-two sash windows, a double-leaf front door, two brick interior chimneys, and a rear shed addition. The one-story gabled rear ell (1894 house) has an enclosed porch on its south elevation, a brick interior chimney, and a projecting gabled entry to the root cellar on its west elevation (HF).
