Written Summary

Owners included Will Ziglar, A. C. Conrad, and Joe Pfaff, who owned the property in 1979. The northern end of the house may have been a later addition (Gwynne Taylor).

This two-story, side-gable-roofed, three-bay, weatherboarded log house has a full-width, early-twentieth-century porch supported by Tuscan columns, two-over-two sash windows, brick end chimneys with stepped shoulders, a metal roof, and a rear ell (HF).
