This one-story side-gable-roofed log house has a modern shed-roofed porch that shelters a nine-over-six sash window and replacement door on the east elevation, a shed-roofed hood over a five-panel door on the south elevation, a board-and-batten door on the west elevation, weatherboards in the gable ends, a brick end chimney on the north elevation, a stone foundation, and evidence of full-width porches on east and west elevations.
